










Classroom Delivery





Are you looking to get started in a career helping others?

The community services sector in Australia is forecasting enormous job growth over the next 5 years.

This qualification may be used as a pathway for workforce entry as a community services worker providing first point of contact and assisting individuals in meeting their immediate needs.

Course Delivery

The CHC22015 - Certificate II in Community Services is delivered within 6 - 12 months in a face-to-face group-based environment with weekly classroom sessions at the school. Learning resources are offered either electronically or paper-based depending on the needs of students and their schools.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to enrol in the VET in Schools program, you must:

- ✓ Be enrolled at school (year 10, 11 or 12)
- ✓ Be resident in Queensland
- ✓ Be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen, or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
- ✓ Have not already exhausted Certificate II VETiS funding

QLD State Government VETiS funding is only available for one Certificate II qualification for each student.

Course Requirements

To achieve a CHC22015 - Certificate II in Community Services a total of 9 units must be completed including 5 core units and 4 elective units as listed below.

Core Units:

CHCCOM005 Communicate and work in health or community services

CHCCOM001 Provide first point of contact CHCDIV001 Work with diverse people

HLTWHS001 Participate in workplace health and safety BSBWOR202 Organise and complete daily work activities

Elective Units:

FSKLRG09 Use strategies to respond to routine workplace problems FSKRDG10 Read and respond to routine workplace information HLTWHS006 Manage personal stressors in the work environment



BSBTWK201 Work effectively with others

Vocational Education and Training in Schools (VETiS) Program

The VETiS program is funded by the Queensland Government to give eligible students funding to complete a Certificate I or II level qualification while attending secondary school.

VETIS qualifications can be undertaken in years 10, 11 and 12, and may provide credit towards the Queensland Certificate of Education.

Aurora Training Institute is a Skills Assure Supplier under this program for the delivery of this Certificate II qualification.

As students can only access the VET in Schools subsidy once, it is important that you consider and compare your training options to ensure they align with your chosen career pathway.

Every student that completes or discontinues a VET in Schools course must complete a Student Training and Employment Survey within 3 months.
