

# **Course Overview**

The CHC33021 - Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) is designed to produce job ready candidates who can provide a person-centred approach in the growing community care industry. This qualification reflects the role of workers in the ageing community and/or residential setting.

## **Course Delivery**

The CHC33021 - Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) is delivered over a period of 35 weeks. Students can choose one of the following delivery options:

- **Classroom:** Weekly classroom sessions are held at our delivery locations with students required to attend three days per week as per the scheduled class times.
- **External:** Students currently employed in the industry at an approved facility can study externally online provided they submit evidence of their employment before enrolment. Students may be required to attend class if directed by their trainer.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

The Certificate 3 Guarantee program has the following eligibility requirements:

- No longer be at school (with the exception of VET in school students); and
- Not have completed or be enrolled in a Certificate III (or higher qualification), this does not include qualifications completed at school; and
- © Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.

#### **Course Requirements**

To achieve a CHC33021 - Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing), 15 units must be completed including 9 core units and 6 elective units. Students are required to complete 120 hours of vocational placement. Prior to commencement of placement, students may be required to obtain or provide evidence of a police check, blue and/or yellow card, first aid certificate and vaccination records.

# **Certificate 3 Guarantee Program**

The Certificate 3 Guarantee program is funded by the Queensland Government and supports eligible individuals to complete their first post-school Certificate III level qualification and increase their skills to move into employment, re-enter the workforce or advance their career.

Aurora Training Institute is a Skills Assure supplier for the delivery of this Certificate III qualification. As you can only access the Certificate 3 Guarantee program funding once, it is important that you consider your training options carefully and ensure they align with your chosen career pathway.

As a condition of your enrolment, you will be required to complete a student training and employment survey within three months of finishing or discontinuing your training.

#### Student Contribution Fee ^

The Student Contribution Fee under the Certificate 3 Guarantee program is \$2 per unit and a **total cost of \$30** (**concessional and non-concessional**). This fee represents the total cost to the student to enrol, undertake training and be awarded the qualification and will be required to be paid before training commences.

<sup>\*</sup> Students are required to complete at least 120 hours of direct support work in at least one (1) aged care, home and community, disability or community service organisation.
