CHC43121 - Certificate IV in Disability Support

Course Overview

If you're passionate about assisting individuals with disabilities, this qualification might be perfect for you. It's designed for those looking to enhance their skills in the disability sector at a higher level in real workplace environments.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Higher Level Skills program, individuals must:

- ✔ Be aged 15 years or over;
- ✔ Be no longer at school;
- ✔ Permanently reside in Queensland;
- ✔ Be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen;
- ✔ Not hold, and not be enrolled in, a certificate IV or higher-level qualification, not including qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training; and
- ✔ Must already hold the Certificate III in Individual Support (or superseded qualification) and be an Existing Worker in the Disability industry sector, which includes parents and unpaid carers of NDIS participants.

Entry Requirements

To enroll in the CHC43121 - Certificate IV in Disability Support, individuals must have completed:

- ✔ CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability), or;
- ✔ CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability), or;
- ✔ CHC30408 Certificate III in Disability including the CHCSS00125 Entry to Certificate IV in Disability Support Skill Set.

Course Requirements

To achieve the CHC43121 - Certificate IV in Disability Support, 10 units must be completed including 7 core units and 3 elective units.

Core Units

- CHCCCS044** Follow established person-centred behaviour supports
- CHCDIS017** Facilitate community participation and social inclusion
- CHCDIS018** Facilitate ongoing skills development using a person-centred approach
- CHCDIS019** Provide person-centred services to people with disability with complex needs
- CHCLEG003** Manage legal and ethical compliance
- CHCMHS001** Work with people with mental health issues
- HLTWHS003** Maintain work health and safety

Elective Units

- CHCADV001** Facilitate the interests and rights of clients
- CHCCCS019** Recognise and respond to crisis situations
- CHCCCS036** Support relationships with carer and family

Higher Level Skills Program

The Higher Level Skills program aims to assist eligible individuals to gain the skills required to secure employment or career advancement in a priority industry or transition to university to continue their studies.

The Higher Level Skills program is funded by the Queensland Government to give eligible individuals a subsidy toward the training costs in selected Certificate IV and above qualifications.

Every student that participates in a Higher Level Skills course must complete a Student Training and Employment Survey within 3 months.

Student Contribution Fee

The Student Contribution Fee under the Higher Level Skills program is \$2 per unit (a total cost of \$20). This fee represents the total cost to the student to enrol, undertake training and be awarded the qualification.
