

## **Course Overview**

Do you want to explore your potential as a leader in the childcare industry?

The CHC50125 - Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care reflects the role of educators in early childhood education and care who work in regulated children's education and care services in Australia.

Educators at this level are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum that meets the requirements of an approved learning framework and for maintaining compliance in other areas of service operations. They use specialised knowledge and analyse and apply theoretical concepts to diverse work situations. They may have responsibility for supervision of volunteers or other educators.

## **Entry Requirements**

Entry to this qualification is open to individuals who hold:

CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care, OR

CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.

Alternatively, individuals may hold:

- An Australian diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care, OR
- An Australian diploma or certificate III in Children's Services, AND
- Demonstrate at least 12 months of cumulative employment (full-time equivalent) within the last 5 years in a regulated education and care service in Australia, supported by verifiable evidence, OR

Hold the CHCSS00147 Entry into Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

# **Additional Entry Requirements**

Aurora Training Institute has additional admission requirements

- 1. International students must be at least 18 years old to enroll with Aurora.
- 2. International students applying for a Diploma level course will need to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of Australian Year 10 (or equivalent) or Certificate IV or higher.
- 3. International Students must provide evidence of meeting the minimum English proficiency requirements.

## **Course Delivery**

The CHC50125 - Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care is delivered in a face-to-face classroom environment over 50 weeks inclusive of practicum hours.

Please note: Prior to placement you will need to obtain a Blue Card for Working with Children.
