

### **Course Overview**

Do you want to grow your skills and become a leader in the childcare industry?

The CHC50125 - Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care describes the work of educators who support children in approved early childhood services in Australia.

Educators at this level are responsible for designing and implementing learning programs that meet the requirements of an approved learning framework and they help keep the service compliant with required standards. They use specialised knowledge to understand and apply key ideas in different work situations. They may have responsibility for supervision of volunteers or other educators.

#### **Entry Requirements**

Entry to this qualification is open to individuals who hold:

CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care,

OR

CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.

## **Additional Entry Requirements**

Aurora Training Institute has additional admission requirements

- 1. International students must be at least 18 years old to enrol with Aurora.
- 2. International students applying for a Diploma level course will need to provide evidence of satisfactory completion of Australian Year 10 (or equivalent) or Certificate IV or higher.
- 3. International students must provide evidence of meeting the minimum English proficiency requirements.
