Course Overview

If you want to make a meaningful difference in the lives of people with disability, the CHCSS00130 Individual Support – Disability Skill Set equips you with the skills to provide safe, respectful, and person-centred care.

Mode of delivery and training arrangements

This qualification is delivered over 26 weeks.

- **Online delivery:** Self-paced learning with one-on-one contact with a trainer.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligible Students must meet the following criteria:

- Student must be a New or Existing Worker in the Community Services and Health Industry in a role involving provision of direct client care or support. Students must already hold a Certificate III in Individual Support (or equivalent).
- Aged 15 years or older.
- Not be a school student.
- Be a permanent Queensland resident.
- Be an Australian citizen, or Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), or a temporary resident with the right visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen.
- Not already have a Certificate IV or higher qualification (including tertiary qualification) completed within the last 10 years (qualifications started as a school student, and foundation skills qualifications, do not count).
- Not be enrolled in any other qualification, whether funded or unfunded, except for foundation skills qualifications.

Career BOOST

Career Boost provides eligible individuals with one subsidised training place in either a Certificate IV, Diploma, or Advanced Diploma qualification under the general training pathway or a higher-level apprenticeship/traineeship at certificate IV or above and up to two subsidised skill sets. Aurora Training Institute is a Skills Assure Supplier under this program for the delivery of this qualification.

The Program delivers training designed to help individuals develop the higher-level skills necessary to secure employment, advance their careers, or progress to further education and training through related university or tertiary qualifications.

Student Co-Contributed Fee

The Student Co-Contributed Fee under the Career BOOST (General Training) Program is \$3.00 per unit and a total cost of \$12 (Concessional and non-concessional) for this qualification. This fee represents the total cost to the student to enroll, undertake training and be awarded the qualification.
